

The Reuben 'Ruby' Leiderman Youth Scholarship Fund

Ruby Leiderman, z"l, was a man who loved all children. He loved nothing more than to see kids, especially teenagers, get the chances he himself was denied as a child of the Depression. He was always willing to drive kids, chaperone events, provide the house for kids to gather, house out-of-towners, in short, whatever it took to make something happen.

To that end, this fund is established to make something happen. This fund is to be used to provide partial funding for attendance at CHUSY regional events. The intent is to make it possible for all interested USYers to be involved at the more costly events offered at the regional level.

The rules governing eligibility are as follows:

- (1) Applicants must be members in good standing of Kehillat Shalom USY.
- (2) Applicant's parents must be members in good standing of Kehillat Shalom.
- (3) No previous award from this scholarship fund shall have been made in the current fiscal year. (one scholarship, per year, per applicant)
- (4) Award amount shall not exceed ½ of the total cost of the program or \$150, whichever is less.
- (5) All awards are to be made anonymously. Checks will be issued to the responsible party, but made out to CHUSY Region to be mailed in conjunction with the application
- (6) Application should be made to the Treasurer or Eileen Leiderman of Kehillat Shalom ***no later than one month*** before the scheduled event. Applicants will be notified of their award and the amount within two weeks. This will enable applicants to complete their registration with the region in a timely fashion. Application may be made in advance of the two month deadline.
